An evacuation checklist will be provided at the conclusion of the evacuation drill for compliance purposes. The purpose of conducting an emergency evacuation training drill is to assist personnel to know their roles and responsibilities in an emergency situation in accordance with the workplace plan and procedures, and to test the workforce response to an emergency.
